Student Acceptance Agreement between Dokkyo University, Japan and Kyiv National Linguistic University, Ukraine

To provide educational opportunities to Ukrainian students, Dokkyo University (Soka City, Saitama, Japan) will offer the support outlined below to students enrolled at Kyiv National Linguistic University (Pechersk, Kyiv, Ukraine).

The two universities will sign an agreement to realize this support, which is currently set up as a temporary measure.

- 1. Dokkyo University may accept students enrolled in a bachelor degree program at Kyiv National Linguistic University (hereinafter referred to as "Accepted Students").
- 2. The period of acceptance will be within one year, between the fall semester of 2022 to the spring semester of 2023.
 - The maximum number of Accepted Students for the entire year is three (3).
- 3. Dokkyo University will make the selection based on Kyiv National Linguistic University's recommendations regarding their affiliated students.
- 4. Accepted Students may take courses determined by Dokkyo University according to their language ability.
 - The students' status at Dokkyo University shall be that of non-degree students.
- 5. Accepted Students shall comply with the laws and regulations of Japan as well as the rules and other regulations of Dokkyo University.
- 6. Dokkyo University shall provide travel and living assistance to the Accepted Students. Dokkyo University shall determine the scope, duration and nature of this support separately based on discussions between the two universities.
- 7. Dokkyo University and Kyiv National Linguistic University will strive to conclude a continuous academic exchange agreement.

If any dispute arises concerning matters covered by this agreement, the two universities shall resolve the dispute in good faith through negotiation. This agreement shall be effective for a period of one year from September 24, 2022.
